TO CAMP ST. ANDREW IN TUNKHANNOCK, PA – YSI LEADERSHIP CAMP

If coming from NY or NJ, take 80 West to 380 West to 81 North. If coming from upstate NY, CT or MA, take I-84 West. Pass through Hartford and cross the Hudson River at Newburgh. Connect to I-81 North. Follow directions below:

The general direction is to **FIRST GET TO SCRANTON, PA**, which is the closest big city.

Once you hit Scranton along Interstate Highway 81:

Take exit #194. The ramp twists and turns. You should follow signs for Clarks Summit two or three times in less than a minute. This will put you on 11N/6W. Reset tripometer. (This is coming from the South.)

9.3 miles after exiting 81, 6W veers to the right. Stay on 11 North.

10.9 miles after exiting 81, look out for a “Camp St. Andrew” sign (on the right side). This signals you to take the next left turn for Lackawanna Trail High School (this sign is also on right side of 11 North).

Turn left to Lackawanna Trail High School and pass the school. Stay on this road for 2.7 miles, until you hit a “T” junction for 92. (You will drive over an “open grate” metal bridge.)

Turn left on Jct. 92 South. Stay on this road for **0.6** miles until you see a gas station on the right side. Just before the gas station there is a road to the right.

Turn right on this road. Stay on this road for **2.0** miles. (This is Avery Station Rd.). At every fork, bear left.

After you take the second fork, on the right side of the road, **there should be a sign for “Camp St. Andrew” pointing left.**

Follow the sign and make a left turn. Stay on this road until it ends. At the end of this road there is a Stop sign. (Also, there should be a T-Town Archery sign straight ahead of you.)

Turn right at the stop sign and the entrance to the camp is approximately 500 yards on your right.
