



Communications: Participation Guidelines

Consider participating in UNIV Communications by writing a paper under the guidance of a teacher/professor. The paper must relate to the general theme of UNIV 2022.

Requirements:

Each presentation must:

1. Be directed by a teacher/professor.
2. Be 6-12 pages long (~2,500-7,000 words).
3. Be delivered as a talk at UNIVForum 2022. The talk should be between 10-12 minutes long.
4. Language: The paper may be written in English, Spanish, Italian, French, German, or Portuguese. The talk (and accompanying PowerPoint) must be in either English or Spanish.

Prizes and Publication:

The Committee will choose winners and runners-up based on the quality of the papers and talks. The best papers will be published in Univ Forum Presentations, an open access journal. Inclusion in the journal may be mentioned in a résumé/CV.

Evaluation:

In making its evaluation, the Committee takes into account the academic level of the students, their attempts to raise big questions and address global problems, and the academic rigor with which their research was carried out.

We note the following criteria:

1. Formal aspects: style, grammar, methodology, quality of the presentation, etc.
2. Content: rigor of the argument, quality of the content, originality of the topic or discussion, etc.
3. Proposed solutions: correspondence of the conclusions with the original objectives, positive tone, quality of the proposals to solve the problems raised, etc.

All participants will be given a certificate that confirms their participation and attendance, and any award granted.
