## High School & Beyond

**A**S YOU BEGIN HIGH SCHOOL, college may seem like something in the distant future. It is not. Before long, you will be taking the SAT, attending college fairs, and poring meticulously over applications. Your options in choosing colleges will be determined by your performance in high school, which begins freshman year. A smart entering 9th grader starts planning his high school career even before the first day of class.

High School & Beyond is designed to help responsible students make the most of their high school years and maximize their college opportunities. The program emphasizes the need to grow in character at the same time as one develops an intellectual life. It also promotes the idea that a high school career should not only be seen as an opportunity to pursue self-development, but also, and more importantly, as an opportunity to learn to put one's talents at the service of others.

The daily schedule includes two classes each morning providing practical tips for success freshman year, sports in the afternoon, a virtue talk, reading and discussion of *A Man for All Seasons*, and night games. There is also daily Mass and times of prayer for those interested. Throughout the week, each participant meets with a mentor who helps him to establish goals for his freshman year in academics, character, friendship, and his spiritual life and to formulate concrete resolutions to achieve those goals.
